

A

If you have a **Train Station**, a judge and a teacher have just arrived in Your Town. They both count as esteemed residents.

Return to your previous panel.

B

If your Approval rating is more than 25 points, a new esteemed resident has just arrived.

Return to your previous panel.

C

If you have more than 300 wood in stock, the cost of your next building is halved.

Return to your previous panel.

D

If you have more Jobs than Population, you attract 10 new residents who will immediately build a **Big House** at no cost to you.

Return to your previous panel.

E

If you have a **Bank**, but you do NOT have a Reinforced Steel Vault, the **Bank** is robbed. You lose **\$1000**.

Return to your previous panel.

F

If you have more Population than Jobs, each building earns you half as much money as planned until this trend is reversed.

Return to your previous panel.

G

If you have buildings next to water, you lose 3 points of your choice (Approval, Safety, Health, Education or a combination) because of a flood.

Return to your previous panel.

H

If you have a good relationship with a doctor, he decides to invest **\$500** in Your Town's future.

Return to your previous panel.

I

If you built a **Prison** close to a **House** (either 2 or 1 squares away), your Approval rating drops 10 points.

Return to your previous panel.

J

If you have a **Snake Oil Stall**, its latest concoction leads to an epidemic of strong diarrhea. Your Approval rating drops 5 points.

Return to your previous panel.

K

If you have more Food than Population, each surplus Food point earns you **\$10**.

Return to your previous panel.

L

If your Safety rating is below 15, your town is attacked by a gang of outlaws. You lose **\$500** and 5 Approval points.

Return to your previous panel.

M

If your Education rating is 10 or higher, the state grants you **\$1000**.

Return to your previous panel.

N

If your Health rating is 7 or higher, a new doctor moves into town. He counts as an esteemed resident.

Return to your previous panel.

O

If you have killed 3 or more men during your adventure, your Safety rating goes up 5 points.

Return to your previous panel.

P

If you own a **Mine**, a new vein was just discovered. You gain **\$1000**.

Return to your previous panel.

Q

A tax collector has just arrived in town and requires 10% of your **Bank Account** (to know how much to give him, divide your money in the bank by 10).

Return to your previous panel.

R

If you have at least 4 **Farms** adjacent to one another, a rat swarm invades and destroys part of your harvest. You lose 10 Food points.

Return to your previous panel.

S

If you have a **Blacksmith**, a fire destroys it along with all adjacent buildings.

Return to your previous panel.

T

If you have a **Train Station**, the train has just derailed. Luckily, nobody was hurt, but you will need to spend **\$500** in repairs.

Return to your previous panel.

U

If you own buildings that share a border with water, your Approval goes up 1 point for each of those buildings.

Return to your previous panel.

V

If you have this key, two bandits attack you. You manage to lose them, but in the process you also lose **\$150**.

Return to your previous panel.

W

If you have a **Hardware Store**, the clerk rewards you for your recent acquisition with a box containing 10 bullets.

Return to your previous panel.

X

If you entered a pact with the natives in which you promised not to kill any animals, and you have broken this pact, all of your buildings in Zone B are destroyed. Lose all benefits for those buildings. Return to your previous panel.

Y

If you've built anything in Zone A, the people who live here are terrified of evil spirits that roam the streets at night. You lose 10 residents and 10 Approval points. Return to your previous panel.
